

August 19, 2018 - 20th Sunday in ordinary time



"I am the living bread that came down from heaven" – those words of Jesus we can hear this month on several Sundays. They remind us of one of the fundamental truths in our faith: Through Jesus, our living bread, we can have eternal life. Each Mass, especially Sunday Mass, confirms that Jesus, our Lord and Saviour, is really present under the Eucharistic spies of the bread and wine. We do not eat some bread or drink some wine in the church but we receive the Body and Blood of Christ. Holy communion is not a symbol of Christ. We believe that receiving the Eucharist we really receive the entire Christ into our hearts. Every Catholic after having the First Communion is invited to receive the Body of Christ during each Mass. From the Lord's side, this invitation is constant and unchangeable but we need to be disposed. What does it mean to be disposed? The Catholic Church teaches that only one who professes the faith in the real presence of the Lord in the Eucharist and is currently freed from any serious sin is able to receive Holy Communion. This is our faith that makes us come to church every Sunday to attend a Mass and to receive Holy Communion.

I would like to thank all who prepared, supported and attended our Annual Feast of Saint Lawrence. We had a beautiful solemn Mass, a prayerful Eucharistic procession and social meal in the hall.

May the Lord through the intercession of our Patron Saint bless our Parish Community!
