September 9, 2018 - 23rd Sunday in ordinary time



In today's first reading God commanded the Prophet Isaiah to say to the people of a fearful heart: "Be strong, do not fear! Here is your God. (...) He will come and save you." Our hearts are challenged by various factors and we become scared especially when something new appears. An ancient Latin proverb says that every beginning is difficult and it is truly impossible to deny it! The Word of God ensures us that besides all fears, threats and worries there is the Lord next to us. This hope of the Divine assistance enables us to walk on the path Jesus has presented to His followers. In our parish community we also begin a new pastoral year with some challenges of an external and internal nature. Yet, trusting that the Lord is with us we are able to move forward.

The project of air-conditioning has been sent to the diocese for approval and hopefully one day we will get it done. Five chasubles, some purificators, corporals, cruets and vessels were purchased. You may see them during the liturgy. The old ones have already lived their time. If you can contribute to these liturgical vestment and vessels it would be greatly appreciated.

May Mother Mary whose nativity we celebrated Saturday intercede for us always!
