From the Pastor's Desk

"Am I not allowed to do what I choose with what belongs to me? Or are you envious because I am generous?"



words These of landowner from today's Gospel parable convey powerful several messages. They challenge human understanding of fairness highlight and the boundless grace generosity of the Lord.

This Gospel account is also a reminder that in God's kingdom there is no room for envy or comparison. Furthermore, the parable speaks to the importance of our attitude and motivation in serving the Lord. The grumbling workers focused on their personal gain and entitlement rather than on gratitude for the opportunity to work.

This Tuesday, September 26th we observe the Feast of St. John de Brebeuf and St. Isaac Jogues and Companions. They worked with the Huron in the 17th century. When the Iroquois took over the Huron village they were captured and ritually tortured, and killed (six Jesuits and two lay persons). In Midland, Ontario there is a shrine dedicated to them as the Canadian Martyrs.

On Friday, September 29th we celebrate a feast of St. Michael, Gabriel and Raphael, Archangels. In Catholic writings and traditions St. Michael acts as the defender of the Church, the chief opponent of the devil and assists souls at the hour of death. There is a well-known and powerful prayer to St. Michael, which Pope Leo XIII brought into official use. In Italy, in the province of Foggia, there is the oldest shrine dedicated to St. Michael in Western Europe. Its beginnings are connected with legendary stories about the first apparitions of St. Michael in the 5th century. According to them, St. Michael appeared with a flaming sword and led the people of Sipontum (Manfredonia) and Benevento to victory over the Neapolitan invaders.

St. Michael, Gabriel and Raphael, Archangels - pray for us!
